She also serves as the Co-Editor of the *CFMS Annual Review* magazine and oversees the CMAJ Student Humanities Blog. The VP Communications is the contact person for any news media requests.

- #HumansOfMedicine social media series and #HowWeAdvocate used to highlight medical student successes and stories
- Coordinating with the Quebec Regional Representative and the Bilingualism Committee to enable the translation of key website pages, press releases and posts into French

- Oversaw the completion of new website development and retirement of old website
- New direct-to-member communications system developed to improve engagement and information flow directly to members *implementation in progress*
- Strategic planning for communications officers to be embedded in portfolios to improve communications efficiency and delivery
- Major expansion of the Communications team to enable more sustainable and efficient workflow and improve collaboration between portfolios
- Successfully advocated for the creation of student and resident-level Joule Innovation Grants: 4 grants of \$5,000 now available this application cycle
