I. DESCRIPTION OF POSITION

From the CFMS bylaws:

- a) Hold the Office of Chair of the Executive Committee; and
- b) Appoint the Chairs of all committees except as otherwise provided; and
- c) Appoint an Executive Vice President from among the Executive Committee; and
- d) Succeed to the Office of Past-President upon the election of their successor; and
- e) Be responsible for the general supervision and direction of the business of the Federation.

At the 2017 CFMS AGM, the general assembly approved a motion for the CFMS past-president to assume chairpersonship of the CFMS board. As a result, the CFMS past-president, Dr. Franco Rizzuti, served as chair of the 2017-2018 CFMS board. The role of the President is multifaceted. The President sets organizational goals and oversees their implementation. Specific activities are delegated to members of the CFMS Board and the President is responsible for providing support, guidance, and institutional memory. The President contributes to agenda-setting for each General and Board meeting. The President is also the designated spokesperson for the Federation and interacts with representatives of media, government, public, and national medical organizations. Representative roles set aside for the President include the Canadian Medical Association Board of Directors, the Physician Resource Planning Advisory Committee, the Canadian Medical Forum, and others by invitation.

• Unmatched Canadian Medical Graduate (uCMG) Crisis

The uCMG crisis remained the number one priority item for the CFMS during my tenure as president. Highlights of my work in this area included:

- Robust conversations with members of the AFMC Residency Matching Committee about supports for uCMGs
- Collaboration with the CMA including their call for provincial and federal governments to urgently increase the number of residency positions for students in this match cycle
- Collaboration with the Canadian Armed Forces to create supernumerary family medicine positions
- o Presentation at the PRPAC December Meeting on the uCMG crisis
- o Joint presentation with the FMEQ at the Canadian Medical Forum meeting on the uCMG crisis
- Teleconferences with representatives at the Ontario Ministry of Health and Longterm care, BC Ministry of Health and the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario.
- o Collaborative work with OMSA on their provincial Lobby Day on uCMG crisis
- Adoption of CFMS motion to allow uCMGs to continue to access CFMS resources and services while still unmatched.
- o Several interviews with various media outlets on the uCMG crisis
- o Meeting with the representatives at the Federal Health Minister's office to discuss the uCMG crisis

Other board portfolios were successful in creating new CFMS-specific supports for uCMGs this year including funding to help with second iteration registration fees, creation of an unmatched student mentorship program and a new unmatched student advisory task force. The CFMS Matchbook this year also includes a section specifically dedicated to students who go unmatched. I am confident that many of the solutions put forward by the CFMS to mitigate the crisis will be realized in 2018, some to impact the current 2018 CaRMS match and the rest for future match cycles. In the meantime, the CFMS will continue to engage with provincial and federal governments as well as the faculties of medicine.

• CFMS Advocacy on the National Stage

For the first time in recent memory, the CFMS was invited to participate in the Federal Government's Stakeholder Lock-up in advance of the unveiling of the 2018 Federal Budget. The budget highlighted the Federal government's response to many key items

that the CFMS has advocated for over the years including funding for health research, indigenous health and the opioids crisis. The budget also announced the creation of a committee to look into a National Pharmacare program. I was also pleased to represent our organization at the National Opioid Symposium at the invitation of the Federal Health Minister's office in early September 2018. The recognition by the Federal Government of the CFMS as a national stakeholder is a testament to the relevance of our organization and the important contributions we must continue to make towards health policy and advocacy.

• Learner Privacy

The CFMS this year was involved in high level conversations with various medical education stakeholders about appropriate learner data stewardship. With the adoption of CFMS Privacy principles at SGM, we are even better positioned to advocate on the issue of learner privacy and ensure that learner data is treated with the highest legal standards.

• CFMS Presidential Tour

I embarked on a tour of our member schools in an effort to meet with CFMS members in person to discuss some of the challenges being faced at their local campuses as well as perceived barriers to CFMS engagement. I successfully met with all CFMS member schools by May 15, 2018. This has been a gratifying initiative and the insights gained from these meetings will help us improve our student engagement strategies as well as better represent our members.

• Opportunities with Joule

We have been increasing our collaboration with Joule and are pleased with the introduction of two student-specific grants as part of the Innovations Grant program. Furthermore, for the first time, a CFMS member will sit on the Joule Innovation Council. I have started preliminary conversations with Joule to explore the possibility for students to complete exchanges with some of their companies including Last Mile Health and Cloud Dx. These would be unique opportunities for students to serve as interns and research assistants. Furthermore, we continue to explore opportunities for to use the Joule Physician Leadership Insitute platform to create courses that are accessible to medical students. I hope to continue these conversations on behalf of the CFMS during my past-presidency year. Finally, thanks to the generosity of Joule, we were able to send 10 CFMS members to the first SingulariyU summit in Toronto. Similarly, our VP Communications and VP Student Affairs represented the organization at TEDMeD in 2017 with new opportunities for general membership to attend in 2018.

It has been a sheer delight working alongside Stephanie over the past year and am certain that she will lead the CFMS to accomplish bigger and better things during her term. To all the CFMS members—the medical students for whom I've had the privilege of representing—thank you for inspiring me every single day to advocate for you and for others on your behalf. The future of healthcare is bright. Yours is a powerful generation. Stay fierce.
